Who We Are

The South DeKalb Tribe is a youth 501-c3 sports organization officially founded August 8, 2015 out of Lithonia, GA. The mission of the organization is to foster good character and future productive citizens through sports and a unique approach at making a positive impact in our community.

We have 75+ student-athletes ages 3-13 with three select teams competing at national baseball and softball tournaments several times a year.

Off the field the organization as a whole also participated in several community involvement events including the Heart of South DeKalb Parade and the Atlanta Lupus Walk. In December 2018, the Tribe hosted its annual Holiday Giveback where Tribe players personally handed out more hygiene and necessity items to the homeless in downtown Atlanta.

Teaching methods used on a daily basis are in full efforts to prepare our student-athletes for life beyond DeKalb County with a 360 approach that allow to them obtain college scholarships, be future leaders, or compete at the professional level.
